Board of Directors Meeting  
August 20, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President Alan Axt at 6:10 PM.

Minutes of the previous meeting were presented by Secretary Tim Bybee.

Frank Lewis made a motion to approve the minutes. Lawrence Aldrete seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Members present were: President Alan Axt, Vice President Carl Chance, Treasurer Frank Lewis, Secretary Tim Bybee, Membership Chairman Lawrence Alderete, Vic Horg, Jeff Zander and Pete Sanchez.. Also present was General Manager Keith Berry and Tournament Chairman Tom Williams..

Not present were Victor Torres and Martin Martinez.

Reports:

Keith Berry: Greens 12 and 15 still need 10 to 15 days before opening. More sod has been ordered to patch bad spots on green 15.

The project to remodel the on course bathrooms will begin soon. Remodeling will include a new roof, tile walls and floor and new fixtures. There will also be coded doors. There will also be work done on a tree project that includes trees at the entrance on Riverside and trees in the parking lot. We are still waiting for final approval by ABC for the liquor licence. The Fresno City Council will decide whether to do the remodel or wait for the building of the new

restaurant. The meeting will be on September 10. If they wait it might save as much as \$80,000 to \$100,000.

Frank Lewis: We started the month with a balance of \$21,648. We collected \$970 in membership fees. We paid the NCGA \$12,855 for membership fees. Our ending balance is \$9,513. The saving balance is \$4,155. There was a motion to accept the report by Tim Bybee. It was seconded by Vic Horg. Motion approved.

Lawrence Alderete: Current Membership is 314.

Tom Williams: A message will go out to all members this week encouraging them to go into Member Planet and update their personal information. It was decided that new members enrollment dates will go from the date they enrolled until the same date in the next year. All members already enrolled will be the same.

Match play results: We lost to Kings River at Riverside. Our final was two wins and four losses.

The Club Championship will be held on September 14 and 15. Players with a handicap of 0-7 will play scratch. All other players will play at scratch in their handicap range. The range will be determined by the number of players that sign up. There will be a super senior flight that will play from the gold tees and use their regular handicaps.

We had positive feedback about the 6-6-6 tournament. Charging \$40 for a one day tournament didn't affect the sign-ups. There were some complaints about the fee.
