Reports:

Keith Berry: There was some disease after the punching of the greens. This caused the need to re-sod green 12 and patches on 9, 10, 11, and both practice greens. Greens 12 and 15 will open on September 1. The new liquor licence has been posted in the restaurant. It will still take 40 to 60 days after posting for ABC to finalize. The restaurant renovation will wait until the liquor licence is active. We will be looking for a new dedicated bartender. .

Frank Lewis: We had \$21,648 in the bank at the beginning of the month. We collected \$970 in membership dues. We paid \$1,020

for shirts for our team shirts. We paid the NCGA membership dues in the amount of \$12,855 . Our ending balance is \$8,512 with \$4,155 in the savings account. There was a motion to accept the report by Tim Bybee. It was seconded by Viv Horg. Motion approved.

Lawrence Alderete: Current Membership is 310.

Tom Williams: On August 10 we will sponsor the 6-6-6 tournament. There will be two drives per person during the first six holes of scramble. The second six holes will be two man best ball. The last six holes will be Chapman Scotch. Handicaps will be researched and E-mailed out before the tournament.

Match play results: We lost at Eagle Springs and we won against Chowchilla at Riverside.
