Reports:

Keith Berry: Both tee boxes and greens were punched the week of June 18 making it necessary to postpone the Senior 4-ball Qualifier until July 6th and 7th. The 15th green has been sprayed and there will be a temporary green for the next 8 weeks. Pure Distinction grass will be sodded in. The front of the green will be softened to make other pin placements possible. The back and north side of the green have been extended. This is the only green that will be done this year. Number 16 will be done next year.

Major changes to the restaurant have been approved and work will start in three weeks. The work will take two to three weeks and

will include a bar facing the river and new high table tops.

Frank Lewis: The balance in the checking account will be \$21,648 and the savings balance was \$4,155. We still need to pay the NCGA for this years dues. Pete Sanchez made a motion to approve the financial report and Vic Horg seconded the motion. .

Lawrence Alderete: Current Membership is 305.

Tom recommends that we change annual memberships to run for 12 months from the date they are first paid. Membership planet will help keep track of the payments.

Match play results: Eagle Springs at Riverside we lost 29 to 7. Riverside at Kings River we lost 27 to 9.

Pete Sanchez made a motion to adopt the new out of bound rules proposed by the NCGA for all local tournaments at Riverside. Carl Chance seconded the motion. Motion passed.
